

Competition Conditions & Privacy Policy

By signing up for the Off-Season Challenge as the coach of the team, you agree to having read the following conditions and privacy notices and to follow them.

1. *FIRST*[®] LEGO[®] League Coach

I note, that each team has to get registered for the Off-Season Challenge by at least one adult coach (min. 18 years). He is responsible for the transfer of the videos of the team as well as for the circulation of the data protection policy to all persons involved. As a coach, I am responsible for obtaining consent for each participating team member from the parent or legal guardian. The prepared form of consent and release can be used. For each season there has to be current consent form signed by the guardian.

2. Communication with the *FIRST*[®] LEGO[®] League organization via e-mail

I note, that the communication will be via the e-mail address of the coach. Therefore, I have to indicate a valid e-mail address for communication purposes with HANDS on TECHNOLOGY e.V.

3. Team number and team members

I agree to use the assigned team number of the current *FIRST*[®] LEGO[®] League season in the registration form for the Off-Season Challenge. I understand, that each team member participating in the Off-Season Challenge must belong to the *FIRST*[®] LEGO[®] League team that signed up to the current season.

4. Participation

The coach must complete the registration form for the Off-Season Challenge and submit the video files until the closing date. Participating in the Off-Season Challenge is free of charge.

5. Evaluation

All applications will be judged by an independent jury and judged by the criteria of innovation, creativity and communication skills. This decision is final and not contestable. The legal process is excluded.

6. Handling the video material

I take note, that the video files will be transmitted via WeTransfer (or a comparable platform) to the organizer HANDS on TECHNOLOGY e.V. and will be viewed there. The videos will be uploaded to the YouTube channel and the websites of HANDS on TECHNOLOGY e.V. and will stay visible for an indefinite time.

7. Privacy Policy

When dealing with team data and video files, HANDS on TECHNOLOGY e.V. strives to be as diligent as possible. We ensure, that we treat the data and video files confidentially and that all legally required technical and organizational activities to ensure data protection are guaranteed.

The collection, processing and usage of all personal data takes place in principle according to the rules of the General Data Protection Regulation.

If a team member cannot show his or her parents' consent, participation of the team member in the Off-Season Challenge is not recommended. Participants or their parents agree, that the video recordings will be stored by HANDS on TECHNOLOGY e.V. for purposes of conducting the Off-Season Challenge and will be reviewed by the judges. The consent can be revoked at any time by e-mail to info@hands-on-technology.org. However, a revocation of the data protection consent to participate in the competition leads to the exclusion of the team from the competition.
