VENUE AND ACCOMMODATION

FLL Open International Lebanon will be hosted at the Lebanese American University, Byblos campus, rated among the top universities worldwide. The Byblos campus extends LAU’s presence 35 kilometers north of Beirut. It is situated in the hillside Blat district, overlooking the ancient city of Byblos (Jbeil) and the Mediterranean Sea.

The site has developed steadily since its inception in 1987 to include a growing number of buildings that cater to seven schools and includes academic, research and administrative buildings, a library and student center, a sports center and a small forest.

The tournament will be utilizing indoor spaces for team pits, robot games, judging sessions and outdoor spaces for entertainment activities.

The city of Byblos renowned for its touristic attraction, which makes the city’s hotels capable of accommodating all the teams depending on their budget. Accommodation discounts will be available on the website within the coming months.



SCHEDULE

June 13: Arrival and pickup from Rafic Hariri International Airport and check-in at hotels.

June 14: Pits open and tour of the old city with multiple stops at attractive locations, local lunch, 2 unofficial rounds, and friendship night.

June 15:

- Opening ceremony.
- Judging sessions.
- 1 official Robot Game match

June 16:

- 2 official Robot Game matches.
- Call-backs and pit visits.
- Closing and Award ceremony.

REGISTRATION FEES

TEAMS:

250 USD per team member and coaches.

Volunteers and Judges are exempted from registration fees.

Visitors:

250USD for Class A, **or** 50USD for Class B*.

Registration fee for teams, volunteers, judges, and class A visitors covers:

- Transportation between airport and chosen event hotels on June 13 and June 17.
- Daily transportation between chosen event hotels and venue.
- Continuous beverages.
- Friendship night and city tour.
- Lunch Boxes for teams, volunteers, and class A visitors.
- Certificates for teams, volunteers and judges.
- Medals for teams and coaches.
- Judges access to buffet lunch and continuous coffee break at invited guests lounge.
